

MBU @ WVU Code of Conduct

Current as of January 4, 2016

Participation by Scouts, Parents/Guardians, other family members, adult Scout leaders, and all WVU personnel is contingent upon their agreeing to and abiding by this code of conduct. All behavior by all involved with MBU @ WVU will be consistent with the BSA Scout Oath and Law (for Boy Scouts and their parents and leaders) or the Girl Scout Promise and Law (for Girl Scouts and their parents and leaders). Scouts, parents/guardians, other family members, and adult Scout leaders are reminded of three key points:

- Scouts are required to remain with their merit badge class group at all times. During pre-registration, lunch, and end-of-the day activities, Scouts are required to remain in designated spaces inside the WVU Rec Center.
- Scouts, parents/guardians, other family members, and adult Scout leaders are guests on the WVU campus and so are expected to represent Scouting in the most positive ways, respecting WVU personnel, property, and facilities, and conducting themselves with courtesy and civility.
- Scouts are required to remain in Class A uniform (Boy Scouts) or Girl Scout uniform throughout the day.

All MBU @ WVU activities are consistent safe Scouting practices and with the "Guide to Safe Scouting," which is available for download from Scouting Safely at www.scouting.org. Additionally, all MBU @ WVU activities are consistent with applicable WVU policies and state of West Virginia policies; merit badge counselors and key volunteers have been trained in Youth Protection per WVU's BOG Policy 49, which is available at information at: <http://employmentservices.hr.wvu.edu/r/download/191248>.
